- All the documents issued overseas must be submitted in **the form of translation and notarization**. In the case of submitting a copy for unavoidable reasons, the original must be checked together and **confirmed by the admissions team**.
- Translation may be in Korean or English.
- Additional documents may be required for qualification examination in addition to submission documents. And please download **Admission Guide** and read all carefully.
- **None of the submitted documents will be returned.**

②	All notarized documents and certificates should be issued after <b>2023 Apr 08</b> . (Excluding Certificate of finance)
③	Submit in order as guided in “ <b>Required Documents</b> ” (p. 5).

### [Note 1] Application Form, Study Plan, and Personal Statement

- [Form 1] Application Form : After online application, print out and submit the documents. (<http://www.jinhakapply.com>)
- [Form 2] Study Plan and Personal Statement : Download application form and type in Korean or English.
- ▶ The application number is automatically assigned after you pay the application fee online.

### [Note 2] Applicant's and Parents' Nationality Documents

- ▶ Documents should be issued after **2023 Apr 8**.
- ▶ Every document must be notarized and translated in **Korean or English**.
- **Other Nationalities except China:** Birth Certificate or Family Relationship Certificate
- **China Nationality:** Household Register (Hogubu)
- ※ If both the applicant and the parents are in **one Household Register**, that one is acceptable.
- ※ **If not, the applicant must submit both** applicant's and parents' Household Registers **and** the family relationship certificate (e.g. birth certificate or family relationship card with notarization and translation in Korean or English).
- ※ In the case of deceased or divorced parents, please submit the death certificate or divorce certificate with notarization and translation in Korean or English.



### [Note 3] Degree Certificates & Final Transcripts

- ▶ Documents must be issued after 2023 Apr 8.
  - ▶ Documents issued overseas must be notarized and translated in Korean or English.
  - ▶ If a transfer student, submit the transcript from the previous university with notarization and translation in Korean or English additionally.
- ※ Documents should be submitted as one of the followings:
1. Consular Authentication: Degree Certificates and Transcripts authenticated by the Korean Embassy/Consulate in applicant's country.
  2. Apostille: Applicants with Degree Certificates and Transcripts from universities in Apostille member nation  
 ※ Refer to [Form 7] and [Appendix #3] for Apostille member nations.
  3. Applicants from Chinese Universities: Degree Certificates and Transcripts issued by China Higher-education Student Information (www.chsi.com.cn)
  4. Graduates (graduates-to-be) from Korean universities: Degree Certificates and Transcripts (consular authentication and Apostille not needed)
- ▶ Admitted applicants who are graduates-to-be or have submitted academic documents without following the above methods must submit them in one of the above methods [Note 3] by **2024 Aug 30 (Fri). Admission will be canceled if the applicants fail to submit documents within the designated period.**

### [Note 4] Certificate of Finance (Bank Balance Certificate and Affidavit of Financial Support)

- ▶ Documents must be issued after 2024 Mar 8.
- ※ If the balance certificate has an expiration date, it is recognized only until the expiration date.
- ▶ The balance should be KRW 16,000,000 or more. (Exchange rate at submission)
  - ▶ Financial guarantor can be the applicant oneself, the parents, or the provisional professor.
    - A photocopy of transaction details is not acceptable.
    - If the total balance is less than KRW 16,000,000 **additional proof is needed.**
    - If Chinese applicant submit certificate of **frozen china bank account**, it should be frozen at least 3 months.

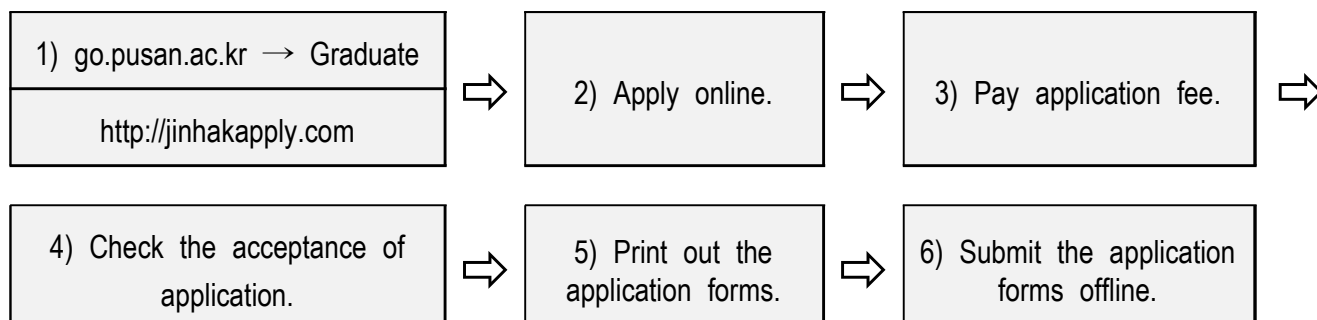
